

BeeGinners Beekeeping Course - Calgary

March 24 & 25, 2012

This course will begin with two full days in the classroom followed by two ½ day field trips during the season.

During the two days of classroom instruction, March 24-25th from 9-5, location at Brentwood CO-OP auditorium you will be introduced to basic beekeeping skills, management and equipment based primarily on the course manual.

The first field trip, in later May, will focus on spring inspection and spring build-up. A second field trip, in late June, will focus on swarm prevention and preparations for the honey flow.

The fee is \$200 for members and includes:

- All four sessions;
- The course manual "Beekeeping in Western Canada";
- Lunches and coffee for the two-day classroom component.

A \$25 association membership is required and may be purchased at the same time.

All sessions will be in or near Calgary.
